I hope you all had a restful Bank Holiday weekend. It was a shame about the weather! Key Stage 1 SATS are now underway and will continue throughout May. It has been a positive start and we are all very pleased and impressed with the children's positive attitude and enthusiasm. Well done. Thank you to all the staff involved with these.

Key Stage 2 SATS Week begins on Monday 13th May. Lots of staff are involved with this process, including myself to facilitate these assessments and our Chair of Governors, Andrew Bradley who will observe the administration of the tests. This will begin with a breakfast each morning for the Y6 children to 'get into the zone'. On Monday, the children will sit the SPAG Papers 1 and 2. On Tuesday, it will be Reading. On Wednesday, Maths Paper 1 Arithmetic and Paper 2 Reasoning. And finally, on Thursday, the children will sit Maths Paper 3 Reasoning.

It has been fantastic to see some of our families involved in the City in the Community Initiative. The cooking smells from the hall were delightful this week!



On Wednesday, staff from all three schools in the Academy Trust met to moderate writing from across the year groups. This was a very beneficial meeting to secure accuracy and consistency of assessment in writing and professional dialogue across the three schools.

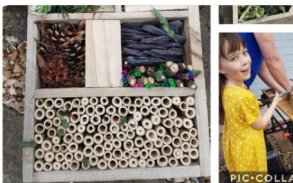
