Dear parents and carers,

Welcome back! You all seemed to have had a brilliant half term holiday. The children raced in through the gates enthusiastically! This is so encouraging. We've a few busy weeks ahead so let's all work together to make the end of term a smooth and fun experience! This week, our Year 1 children have had their statutory Phonics Check. If you have any questions, please see the Year 1 team or Mrs Budgett.

In June 2020, a national Multiplication Tables Check will be made statutory for all primary schools. At St Wilfrid's we have decided to opt into the voluntary 'trial' check this year with our Y4's before it becomes statutory next year. The multiplication tables check is designed to help ensure children in primary school know their times tables up to 12 off by heart. The Multiplication Tables Check has been described as an online, on-screen digital assessment – meaning the children will take the test on a desktop or device. I have decided to do the trial this year so we can evaluate what the check process looks like, and how our children can be best supported. I am not anticipating any issues with this. The team are prepared and ready and the children will enjoy the process. We have planned to administer the check during the two weeks beginning Monday 17th June 2019.
