

Local Artists – Whole School

Aims and outcomes:

- Children to have an understanding of how art changes in different countries.
- Children to compare and contrast their learning with those in another culture.
- Children to learn about the cultures in other countries in the present day.

Activities:

Pupils learnt about a national artist of our partner school in Barcelona; Picasso. Each year group produced a piece of art work in the style of Picasso, in exchange for work from school in Barcelona on Lowry. Children learnt about each other's cultures, local area and the history of the artists. We shared our work with the other school and they sent samples of work based on Lowry a local artist to Manchester.

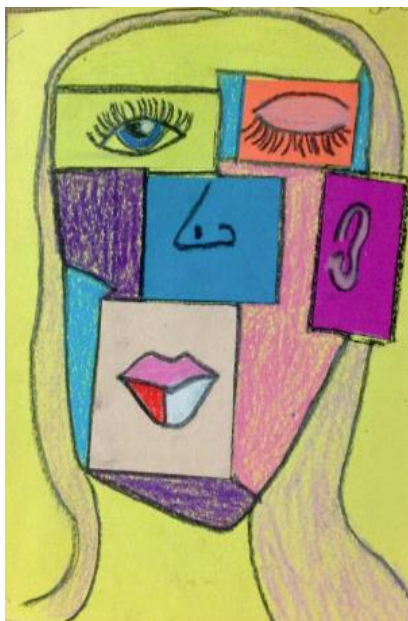
EYFS looked at shape and colours of Picasso's work:
